2. Project Brief & Geographical Coverage

PHIA Foundation is implementing Project in Khaltsi, covering six village of Leh district. Khaltsi region has been chosen due to its unique combination of cultural significance, livelihood challenges, and climate vulnerability. This region is home to rich traditional practices such as stone carving and apricot farming, which are integral to Ladakh's heritage but are at risk of decline due to lack of modernization and poor market linkages.

To enhance the productivity, safety, and precision of stone carving artisans in Khaltsi block by equipping the community centre with modern tools, advanced machinery, and essential infrastructure. This intervention aims to preserve traditional craftsmanship while promoting sustainable livelihoods.

3. Scope of Work & Deliverables:

Under the program, we are setting up a Stone Carving Centre. The selected vendor(s) will be responsible for the following as follows:

- Specialized components: ball bearings for rotating carved stones
- Expert training sessions (resource person fee and food included)

B. Installation & Setup

- On-site delivery and installation of all machinery and tools
- Electrical fitting and functional setup of CNC and cutting machines
- Arrangement of furniture and layout optimization for workflow
- Safety compliance checks and demonstration of equipment use

C. Training & Orientation

- Conduct 4 expert-led training sessions for artisans on equipment usage, safety, and maintenance
- Provide manuals and SOPs for each machine/tool

- Functional installation of machinery and infrastructure
- Completion of training sessions and submission of attendance records
- Submission of warranty documents, user manuals, and installation report.
- Final invoice with itemized breakdown and signed delivery note

- The service provider/vendor/Manufacturer will be required to provide a fully working solution shall be deployed at the project location. The vendor(s) shall also ensure service support, for the solution provided.

- Ability to provide after-sales service and warranty support.
- GST registration and compliance with government procurement norms
- Capacity to deliver and install in remote locations of Ladakh

7. Quality Assurance & Compliance

- All equipment must meet BIS/ISO standards
- · Safety gear must comply with occupational safety norms
- Installation must be certified by a qualified technician
- Any defective items must be replaced within 10 days of delivery

8. Payment Terms

- 40% advance upon work order issuance
- 40% upon delivery and installation
- 20% upon completion of training and submission of final documentation.
